Education And Credentials

Terry Fox earned his Master of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine degree from the Colorado School of Traditional Chinese Medicine in August 2006. This four-year program consists of 2,520 hours of education including 525 hours of clinical practice. He was certified as a Diplomate in Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) in August 2006. This includes certification in Clean Needle Technique and Chinese Herbology. Terry earned his certification in Therapeutic Massage in 1999 from the Utah College of Massage Therapy. The nine-month program consisted of 1,143 hours of didactic and hands-on training.

Terry Fox's training includes adjunctive therapies such as Cosmetic Acupuncture, Constitutional Facial Acupuncture, Cosmetic Rejuvenation Acupuncture, Facial Gua Sha, Microneedling, Moxibustion, Tui Na, Swedish and Russian massage, CranioSacral therapy, Acupressure, Cupping, Auriculotherapy, and Dietary/Lifestyle recommendations. Terry is a member of the Acupuncture Association of Colorado. He is a Licensed Acupuncturist (CO #1219) and Licensed Massage Therapist (CO #7370). Terry has never had any license, registration or certification suspended or revoked.
